Introduction

Many think that the Anointing, Power and Baptism of the Holy Spirit is only for one set of people or for specific church or denominations or separate Christian groups. It is not right. The Anointing and Baptism of the Holy Spirit is a new experience for every believer, so everyone should ask God and long to receive it. Our Lord led His disciples and His Apostles, with the Power and Anointing of the Holy Spirit. They were moved with the Spirit of God and wrote what God revealed them, which is "**The Holy Bible**". Also as we read in Acts, churches grew because The Holy Spirit moved in a mighty way and the gifts of the Holy Spirit operated in different levels to edify the body of Christ. If our Lord did not lead His Disciples and His Apostles with the Power and Anointing of The Holy Spirit on and after the day of Pentecost, then we would not have any books written after John the Gospel in The Holy Bible

Today, many Christian leaders do not have this personal experience, so they do not believe in the Anointing of The Holy Spirit and try to ignore, confuse others within the body of Christ. But they love to preach from the books written by Paul the Apostle or from other disciples. They love to do Bible researches or Bible studies from these books (written by Paul the Apostle) not knowing it was written by the special anointing given by The Holy Spirit. Paul the Apostle, was filled by the Holy Spirit, walked in the Spirit, was anointed and baptized with the power & fire of the Holy Spirit through which all gifts operated (like Faith, Word of knowledge, Word of wisdom, speaking in Tongues, Interpretation of Tongues, Prophecy, Miracles & Healings through the Power of The Holy Spirit) and edified the Body of Christ. The same happened with other Disciples, Apostles, Teachers, Pastors and Evangelist as we read in the book of Acts

With this thought and introduction, let us have an open mind to know and understand more about the Anointing and Baptism of The Holy Spirit, so that our Lord may fill us more, for His purpose as He promised us through Prophet Joel in Old Testament.

Who is The Holy Spirit?

He is God's Holy Spirit. The Spirit of God. The Spirit of Christ. The following verses from the Holy Bible will clearly explain,

- *He is God's Holy Spirit (His Spirit) - 1 Thessalonians 4:7,8*
- *His (God's) Spirit - 1 John 4:13, 1 Corinthians 2:10, Romans 8:9,11*
- *The Spirit who is from God - 1 Corinthians 2:12*
- *The Spirit of Him (God) - Romans 8:11, 1 Corinthians 2:11, Acts 5:9*
- *The Spirit of Christ - Rom 8:9, John 20:22, Galatians 4:6, Philippians 1:19*
- *The Holy Spirit is part of The Trinity who bear witness in Heaven along with God the Father & with Jesus Christ - 1 John 5:7*
- *The Holy Spirit is The Advocate, sent by Father to us - John 14:26, John 15:26*

➤ *He is the Spirit of wisdom and revelation - Ephesians 1:17*

We find few people worship only God the Father (God Yahweh) not worship Lord Jesus Christ or His Holy Spirit. Some worship only Lord Jesus Christ. Some worship both God the Father and Lord Jesus Christ, leaving The Holy Spirit (not giving any importance). Some worship and give priority only to The Holy Spirit and His gifts. They believe in God the Father and Lord Jesus Christ, but they are interested only with the operation of gifts of The Holy Spirit more than anything. If we fall under any of the above mentioned category then we are not at the right path.

The Holy Bible says all three are ONE, God the Father, His Son and our savior Lord Jesus Christ and His Spirit, The Holy Spirit. We should give equal importance to all three of them. All three are ONE, which is the greatness and uniqueness of Trinity. We should not neglect any one of them at any point of time. We should honor and fear them equally. When we do not understand this truth, we fall for different cult groups. We cannot please and worship God the Father only, without worshiping Lord Jesus Christ and The Holy Spirit. We cannot please and worship our Lord Jesus Christ only, without worshiping God the Father and The Holy Spirit. We cannot please and worship The Holy Spirit only, without worshiping God the Father and our Lord Jesus Christ. Equal reverence should be given to all three of them. May all Glory, Honor and Praise be to GOD the Father, our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and His Holy Spirit for ever and ever. Amen

We find the existence of Holy Spirit even before the earth was created, as we read in Genesis 1:2, "*And the Spirit of God*

moved upon the face of the waters". We also read in many places in Old Testament about the existence of Holy Spirit,

- *King David when he sinned against God, he says in Psalm 51:11, "Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me"*
- *In Isaiah 63:10 we read, "Yet they rebelled and grieved his Holy Spirit"*
- *In Numbers 11:29 we read, "And Moses said unto him, Enviest thou for my sake? Would God that all the Lord's people were prophets, and that the Lord would put his spirit upon them!"*
- *In 1 Samuel 10:10 we read, "And when they came thither to the hill, behold, a company of prophets met him; and the Spirit of God came upon him, and he prophesied among them"*
- *In Numbers 24:2 we read, "And Balaam lifted up his eyes, and he saw Israel abiding in his tents according to their tribes; and the spirit of God came upon him"*
- *Daniel had Holy Spirit - Daniel 4:8,9,18, Daniel 5:11*
- *Spirit of Lord was with Samson - Judges 14:6,19*

During Old Testament days, we find that The Spirit of God dwelt among anointed Prophets who walked closer with God. They carried the presence of God and prophesied for Nations and Kings. God anointed these Prophets and used them to lead nations under the guidance of The Holy Spirit. When the Spirit of God came upon them, they spoke with boldness before Kings, giving message or plan from God and in some situations even warn them as The Spirit of God led them

What will The Holy Spirit do?

The Holy Bible says,

- *HE is our TEACHER. HE will interpret or teach Spiritual things to Spirit filled people - 1 Corinthians 2:13*
- *HE will testify about Jesus Christ - John 15:26, 1 John 4:2*
- *He will search the deep things of God and reveal to us. HE knows everything of God - 1 Corinthians 2:10-11*
- *HE will reveal many unknown things to HIS Holy Apostles & Prophets – Ephesians 3:5, Luke 10:21-22, 1 Corinthians 2:10, Luke 2:25,26*
- *HE will overshadow us - Luke 1:35*
- *HE is our Comforter or Helper - John 14:16, John 15:26*
- *HE is The Spirit of Truth - John 14:17, John 15:26*
- *HE is witness to God - Acts 5:32*

- *HE will dwell with you & will be in you - John 14:17, 1 Corinthians 3:16, 2 Timothy 1:14*
- *HE will help us - 2 Timothy 1:14*
- *HE will do intercession for HIS people (saints) - Romans 8:26-27*
- *HE will help in our weakness - Romans 8:26*
- *HE will separate people for HIS Ministry or fulfill HIS Calling - Acts 13:2*
- *HE will warn us for the hardship we will face in Ministry - Acts 20:23*
- *HE will strengthen us and give us HIS Power - Acts 1:8*
- *HE will sanctify us - 1 Peter 1:2, 1 Thessalonians 5:23, 2 Thessalonians 2:13*
- *HE will teach you what to speak or say - Luke 12:12*
- *HE will make us to be witness for Christ - Acts 1:8*
- *HE will deliver people from evil Spirit and bondages - Matthew 12:28*
- *HE will give us Joy - Acts 13:52, Luke 10:21, 1 Thessalonians 1:6*
- *HE will encourage us - Acts 9:31*
- *HE will pour out God's Love - Romans 5:5*
- *HE will fellowship with us - 2 Corinthians 13:14*
- *HE gives us understanding - Colossians 1:9*

The above are some characteristics mentioned about The Holy Spirit. When we pray, read and meditate His word, we will come to know more about Him. You will also have an excellent personal relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ, His Holy Spirit and walk with Him daily

There are few things which we should not do or go against The Holy Spirit. As the Bible says,

- *Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God - in Ephesians 4:30. Our actions or words we speak or things we do should not grieve The Holy Spirit*
- *Do not blasphemy against the Holy Spirit (It is an unforgivable sin) - in Matthew 12:31-32, Mark 3:29, Luke 12:10*
- *Do not resist the Holy Spirit (like Jews) - Acts 7:51*
- *Do not lie against The Holy Spirit. He knows everything - in Acts 5:3-10. We read the penalty for this act was death because they lied boldly to the Spirit of the Holy God. This is a good lesson to every believer*

Even though our Lord is a forgiving God, full of mercy and grace, with love and compassion on the other side He is a jealous God. He cannot share His Glory with anyone. When people of Israel went against Him, His anger came upon them. He always fights for His people when others persecute them for the sake of Gospel. One side He is a God of Love and on the other end He is a God of Consuming Fire. Faithful, Truthful, Loving and Holy God. He will never leave us or forsake us

The Holy Bible says in Matthew 12:32, Mark 3:29,

Luke 12:10, that anyone who speaks against or blasphemes against The Holy Spirit will never be forgiven; they are guilty of an eternal sin. In simple words, anyone who mocks or makes fun of The Holy Spirit knowingly, will need to pay a price or penalty for it. This will be the only sin which cannot be forgiven by our Lord Jesus Christ, when someone makes fun or mock The Holy Spirit, who is the Spirit of the Living God who created you, me and everything. In Matthew 18:21-22, Jesus asks us to forgive anyone seven seventy times. He has a heart full of love and compassion, and is always ready to forgive a person who comes to Him at any moment. At the same time, when we have a relationship with Christ after being added to the Body of Christ, if we mock or make fun or talk bad about The Holy Spirit, then the Bible says, we are guilty of an eternal sin which will not be forgiven. This was spoken by our Lord Jesus Christ. In other words, if our Lord Jesus Christ says that this is an eternal sin which will not be forgiven, then we cannot make to heaven for sure. So we need to be careful about what we speak or tell about The Holy Spirit. This is very important which we need to know and also tell our kids, family members, relatives, friends and our generations in the days to come

In 1 Corinthians 2:12 we read, "*The spirit who is from God, is freely given to us by God*". God has given His Spirit, The Holy Spirit for free. We do not need to pay any special price to receive Him. When we accept our Lord Jesus Christ, by asking Him to come into our heart, He comes into our heart cleanses our sins by His precious Blood and makes us a new person. At that moment, we become part of the Body of Christ by His Grace. He also gives us His Holy Spirit who stays in our heart and gives us the Joy and Peace. The Bible says in 1 Corinthians 3:16, "*Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?*" When we accept Christ into

our heart, we become the temple of our Living God and His Spirit dwells in us. This is how we receive The Holy Spirit into our heart. Also as we read in 1 Peter 1:16, "*Be holy, because I am holy*". Our God is a Holy God and He expects us to live a Holy life in this world. It is not easy to live a Holy life because we face many challenges. We specially need our Lord's grace every day and His Holy Spirit to help us to live a Holy life by teaching and guiding us in every step. The Holy Spirit tells our heart what is not right when we are about to commit sin. He will alert us and teach us. But when we again sin against God, The Holy Spirit will not dwell in us. The Bible very clearly says in Judges 16:20, The Spirit of God departed from Samson when he fell for sin. The Holy Spirit is God's Spirit, He is Holy. He cannot dwell among a person who keeps sinning when our bodies are defiled with sin. This is the reason why devil wants us to sin. He knows that when we sin, The Holy Spirit will not dwell in us. The chosen Samson lost the grace of God and The Holy Spirit when he sinned against God. He never knew when the Spirit of God left him. It will be the same for us. When we sin against God, we will not know when The Holy Spirit left us because He is a Holy person and cannot dwell among sinful acts. It is not that He wants to leave from us; it is because we have sinned and He cannot dwell in us. He does not want to leave us and forsake us. But as we read in Isaiah 59:2, our sins separate us from God and when it happens, The Holy Spirit leaves us. Certain things are given as examples in The Bible, so we can learn from them and not to fall for sin. So when The Holy Spirit departs from us and when we do things without Him, it becomes just an event in our life and nothing more. Unless The Holy Spirit works in a person there will be no change in anyone's heart. If the Holy Spirit is not there, then there is no work of God seen in anyone or through anyone or through any local church,

any ministry or through any outreach. This is very important and every believer in Christ should understand

In John 20:22 we read, Jesus Christ breathed on His disciples and said, ***“Receive the Holy Spirit”***. He breathed on them His Spirit and asked them to receive The Holy Spirit. His disciples received His Holy Spirit. The disciples were walking, talking, sleeping and doing ministry along with Lord Jesus Christ for more than three years. During that time Lord Jesus Christ was there with them. When He was about to leave them before being taken to Heaven, Lord Jesus made sure His disciples received The Holy Spirit who can teach them how to do His Ministry from that point onwards, so He asked them to receive His Spirit. At the same time as we read in Acts 1:4-5, our Lord commanded His disciples to wait together in one place so He will anoint them with ***“the Baptism of The Holy Spirit”*** which was promised by God the Father. At that point when He said, His disciples have received The Holy Spirit but not the Baptism and Anointing of The Holy Spirit. Hence Jesus Christ asked them to wait in one place and prepare themselves in prayer, to receive the Baptism and Anointing of The Holy Spirit. We need to understand that both are different. Often many get confused with these two. Many wrong doctrines emerge from these confusions. Receiving The Holy Spirit is not the same as receiving the Baptism and Anointing of The Holy Spirit. It is very important for every believer or child of God to understand this. If we do not understand this clearly, we will not have a heart to seek for the Baptism and Anointing of The Holy Spirit. This is also called as ***“Filling of The Holy Spirit”*** or ***“Baptism and Anointing of The Holy Spirit”***

Why do we need the Anointing of The Holy Spirit?

First and most importantly it is the Promise of God the Father as we read in Acts 1:4, that He will baptize us with His Holy Spirit for a specific reason. God is giving us the Baptism of The Holy Spirit for a reason and that is to expand His Kingdom in earth through us

Secondly as we read in Isaiah 61:1-3, our Lord is anointing us to preach the good news of Salvation which is the Gospel, to heal the broken hearted, to release people who are bound, to comfort who mourn, to give them beauty for ashes and garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness, to glorify God in everything we do. Our Lord is giving the Baptism of The Holy Spirit for the expansion of His work in earth and not for any other reason. This is very important for everyone to understand

Thirdly to edify them in the spirit and to edify the body of Christ as we read in 1 Corinthians 14

Finally to truly worship our God in spirit and in truth as we read in John 4:24

Who can baptize with The Holy Spirit?

The Bible says in Acts 1:5, Acts 11:16, Matthew 3:11, Mark 1:8, Luke 3:16, only our Lord Jesus Christ can baptize us with The Holy Spirit and Fire. He is the only person who can give us. Anyone who asks Him will receive it. This is the promise He gave us in Matthew 7:7. In 1 Corinthians 14:1 the Bible says, desire spiritual gifts. These gifts will be given to anyone, only when they are baptized with The Holy Spirit, by our Lord Jesus Christ

How do we know that our Lord has baptized us with His Holy Spirit?

Whenever our Lord baptizes His people with The Holy Spirit and Fire, He confirms it with the Gift of Tongues. We clearly read this in many places in the Bible. If we read in Acts 2:1-11, on the day of Pentecost, when our Lord anointed His disciples with Power and Fire, they spoke in Tongues

We also find the same in Acts 10:44-46, when Peter was speaking and sharing the message of God, The Holy Spirit fell on the gentiles and they spoke in tongues

Also in Acts 19:6, when Paul laid hands on them, The Holy Spirit came on them and they spoke in tongues

In all these three situations, we find our Lord confirms the Anointing, Power and Baptism of The Holy Spirit with speaking in Tongues which is one of the gifts of The Holy Spirit. When we read in 1 Corinthians 14:4 The Bible says, *"He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself"*

Our Lord gives us this gift when He baptizes us with The Holy Spirit to edify us. Unless we are edified by His Spirit, we cannot edify the body of Christ. So our Lord Jesus Christ gives us this special gift when He anoints us with His Holy Spirit

Who will receive the Baptism of The Holy Spirit?

The Bible says in Joel 2:28-29 and Acts 2:17-18, *“In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, your old men will dream dreams. Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days, and they will prophesy”*

Also when we read in Acts 2:38, Peter said to them, *“Repent and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit”*

Also we read in Luke 11:13, *“If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!”*

In Acts 5:32 we read, *“We are witnesses of these things, and so is the Holy Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey him”*

So Holy Spirit is given to everyone who obeys God totally

When we repent and accept Christ into our heart, He is ready to baptize us with His Holy Spirit. He will pour out His Spirit on everyone who is willing to receive Him. We should ask God to fill us. But in the last days as the Bible says, He will pour out His Spirit on everyone whether you ask Him to fill you or not.

Those days are not very far from now. Your sons and daughters will prophesy. Amen. They will speak word of life on you or to anyone as the Lord leads them. They might not know what they are speaking but they will be touching many lives. Amen. Young people will see visions. God will show them visions and reveal His plans through visions. Old people will see dreams. God will show them dreams and reveal His plans through dreams. God will pour out His anointing on His servants, they will prophesy. Amen

My prayer is, Lord I want to see and witness all these things before I leave this world to meet you. Based on all prophecies being fulfilled for our Lord's second coming, these days are not very far from now. Our Lord is preparing His church for final day's revival. Whatever it is, may our Lord's will only be done in earth as it is in Heaven

How Lord can anoint you with His Holy Spirit?

We find our Lord filled His people with the Anointing of The Holy Spirit in three different ways,

- *In Acts 2:1-11, when the disciples prepared themselves, sanctified, prayed and they were together in one accord, our Lord filled them. Verse 1 mentions that our Lord filled them when they were together in one accord in one place (they were not even praying during that time)*
- *In Acts 10:44-46, When Peter was sharing the message and when the Gentiles believed Christ, they received the anointing of the Holy Spirit.*
- *In Acts 19:6, when Paul lays his hands, they received the anointing of the Holy Spirit and in Acts 8:17 - Then Peter and John placed their hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit.*

So our Lord can use any means to anoint you with His Power and Fire. Repent and give your life totally to our Lord Jesus Christ. Allow Him to fill you. Have a thirst to know more about Christ and allow Him to work in your life. He will fill you

more than what you ask for and use you for the expansion of His Kingdom. God can fill you when you pray alone also or while praying with a group of people or when you listen to His word or a servant of God lays hands upon you like Paul the apostle who carried special anointing of God. So do not worry about how our Lord will fill you. He will fill you with the Anointing of The Holy Spirit at the right time and at the right moment, so our Lord's will be done through you. Amen.

Also many think this is some Pentecostal experience or this belongs to some people who belong to Pentecost Church. No it is not so. It is wrongly interpreted by people who do not have this experience or have such closer walk with The Holy Spirit. If it is only for a certain kind of people, our Lord will not have these things in the Bible and we will not have any books after John the Gospel or the whole Bible would have be given to people who go to Pentecost church only. Many have this wrong thought or misinterpretation. This experience is needed for everyone who has accepted Christ. During last days if you walk with Christ, our Lord will fill you. This is the promise and prophesy as we read in Joel 2. If people do not believe this and keep mocking, our Lord will use their sons or daughters to prophesy over them when He anoints their kids. The people who mock will watch and witness with their own eyes. In the last days this is how our Lord will reach them, when they do not believe in His word or message through His servants

If you are doing God's work or His ministry then definitely you need the Baptism of The Holy Spirit. He will give you the power, fire, zeal and boldness to do His work

While taking His disciple Peter's life as an example, we will be able to understand it better with few verses from the Word of God. When we read in,

- *Matthew 16:18-19 - our Lord told Peter that He will build His Church upon him*
- *Matthew 16:23 - Peter allowed Satan to come inside and Lord said to Peter, "Get Behind Me, Satan"*
- *Matthew 26:34 - Jesus predicts Peter's denial*
- *John 18:15-18, 25-27 - Peter denies Jesus 3 times. He wept & realized that he denied Christ*
- *Luke 22:31-32 - Jesus prayed for Peter to build his faith because Satan was asking for Peter's life*
- *John 21:1-14 - Peter backslides and goes back to Fishing.*
- *John 21:15-19 - Jesus restores Peter again to build His Church upon him*
- *Acts 2:1-4 - Jesus anoints Peter with the Baptism of Holy Spirit (**From here Peter's Ministry was powerful**)*
- *Acts 2:14-47 - Peter's first sermon after the Anointing of Holy Spirit, 3000 people were saved*
- *Acts 3:1-10 - Peter heals a lame man in Jesus Name - Gifts of the Holy Spirit operates through him*
- *Acts 3:11 to Acts 4:4 - Peter's second sermon and 5000 people were saved*
- *Acts 4:8 - Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit (had an overflowing experience)*
- *Acts 4:13 - Peter was bold after receiving the Anointing of Holy Spirit*

- *Acts 5:1-11 - Gift of discerning Spirit operates through Peter. He found Ananias & Sapphira lied to the Holy Spirit.*
- *Acts 8:17 - Then Peter and John placed their hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit*
- *Acts 10 - Peter sees vision from God and our Lord Opens door for Gentiles too through him*
- *Acts 10:44-46 - When Peter was sharing the Word of God, many Gentiles received the anointing of the Holy Spirit and also the Gifts*

We can see how Peter's life was before the Baptism of The Holy Spirit and how Peter served God after he received the Anointing of The Holy Spirit. This is the reason we need the Anointing of The Holy Spirit, so our Lord can use you more. He will give you the zeal, boldness and power to work for Him, so that we will be able to do His will

The time we surrender to Him completely, fast and pray, do according to His will and allow the Holy Spirit to work through us, then we find our Lord using us like Peter. There will be a huge change in the ministry for which our Lord ordained us to do.

Fruit of The Holy Spirit

In Gal 5:22-23 we read about nine fruits of The Holy Spirit, *"But the fruit of the Spirit is Love, Joy, Peace, Longsuffering, Kindness, Goodness, Faithfulness, Gentleness and Self-control"*. When The Holy Spirit comes and dwells in our heart, He will change and help us to come out of areas where we are addicted to sin. We might be addicted to few hidden sins due to our own regular habits or sins to which we are slaves or strongholds in our life or through curses in our families passing through generations. When we accept Christ into our heart, every sin will be cleansed by the Blood of Christ and curses will be broken in the Name of Jesus. But enemy knows our weakness and he will try to touch us in areas where we were addicted. The Bible says in Mark 9:29, *"This kind (evil Spirit) can come out by nothing but prayer and fasting"*. So when we fast and pray, God gives us His grace to overcome these addicted areas so we do not fall again and again. That is the reason why fasting and prayer is very essential for every believer

The more we allow The Holy Spirit to work in our lives; the more He will show us the areas we need to surrender, be cleansed and reconciled with God. Through cleansing by the Blood of Christ we can come back to God, and then we can find

the Fruit of The Holy Spirit operating in our lives. As we read in Luke 6:43-45, "*For a good tree does not bear bad fruit, nor does a bad tree bear good fruit...For every tree is known by its fruit....A good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth good*". If we do not surrender our life totally to Christ, we will not have these Fruit of The Holy Spirit in our life nor experience them in full.

The Anointing and Baptism of The Holy Spirit is not a one time or a one day experience. We need our Lord to anoint us daily, with His new and fresh anointing. The more we surrender; our Lord is ready to fill us more with His new anointing. Unless we are filled with His fresh new anointing, we will not be a useful vessel in His kingdom. Our Lord anoints us based on how He wants to use us. We need to allow The Holy Spirit to take control of us and work according to His will in our life to glorify His Name. Ask our Lord to fill you with fresh new anointing every day with the confirmation of speaking in new tongues. Do not be happy and content with the same anointing. Ask God to anoint you more, so that He can use you more for His work.

Gifts of The Holy Spirit

The Bible tells about nine gifts of The Holy Spirit in 1 Corinthians 12: 4-11...."*The word of Wisdom, The word of Knowledge, Faith, Gift of Healing, Working of Miracles, Prophecy, Discerning of Spirits, Different kinds of Tongues, Interpretation of Tongues*". All nine gifts are different, but operated by the same Spirit of God to edify the Body of Christ. There are differences in ministries, but the same Lord. And there are diversities of activities, but it is the same God who works in all. But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all. But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as our Lord wills. As given in Hebrews 2:4, "*By gifts of the Holy Spirit distributed according to HIS will*"

Our Lord gives us these gifts according to His will only when He baptizes or anoints a person, which is why it is called as a “**Gift**”. It is not given to everyone except the gift of speaking in Tongues, which our Lord gives to everyone when He anoints them with The Holy Spirit to edify their spiritual life. All other Gifts of The Holy Spirit operate based on divine calling, which our Lord ordains and uses accordingly at the right time

when it is needed. All other gifts edify the Body of Christ and the result is to expand the Kingdom of God only. Wherever we find the gifts of The Holy Spirit operate, there are souls added in Lord's Kingdom (we read in different places in the Book of Acts). These gifts of The Holy Spirit are not operated for any individual's name or fame. It is very important to know this. Many have lost the gifts of The Holy Spirit when they used them for their own glory. The Bible says, Our Lord is a Jealous God. He will never share His Glory with anyone or any man made idols. He is the ONLY Living God. Amen

The servants of God who have the gifts of The Holy Spirit have to be very careful especially with their daily walk with God. The enemy will target them first to make them fall. If they sin, they will lose all the anointing and the gifts of The Holy Spirit, so souls cannot be added in God's Kingdom. This is the plan of the enemy. A servant or child of God will have more trials, tribulations, temptations, problems, physical, mental and financial challenges than other people. But in midst of all these challenges, they will still trust God completely and keep moving, looking for His grace every day and serve others as Lord leads them with fasting & prayers. A normal person will not understand this unless they really put themselves in the shoes of a servant or child of God who goes through these problems. It is very easy to talk and find fault with any servant of God. But the most important thing is, are we really praying for them every day? More than praying for them, we keep talking or gossiping about them to others. Let us not judge any servant of God. They are accountable to God one day for sure for what they have done in this world. Whenever we hear about their faults, let us pray for them. If we regularly pray for them and their families then they will not fall or backslide. We are responsible if they backslide because we did not pray for them regularly. Our Lord

has given us the grace to identify issues, challenges they face and make us pray for them and those issues.

We read in the Bible, David never touched King Saul and he always gave respect to the anointing King Saul carried. King Saul did many things against David. David still gave respect to the anointing King Saul carried. Pastors, servants of God, missionaries carry the same anointing of the Holy Spirit and they have been ordained by our Lord for a specific purpose. If you do not respect them, at least do not talk bad about them and let us make a point to pray for them. Are we praying for our local church pastors, missionaries, servants of God and their family daily? If not, let us start doing for them. Even a small two minute prayer for them and their families will be of great support in His Kingdom. As believers in Christ, we need to specially pray for these saints or people of God who carry this divine anointing and the gifts of The Holy Spirit. This is what The Holy Spirit will do when He anoints a person; He will do intercession for His people (saints) as we read in Romans 8:26-27, so they do not fall and lose the anointing and the gifts of the Holy Spirit. We will not go in detail of every gift except the gift of speaking in Tongues because it is necessary to know or understand clearly. Many get confused with the gift of speaking in Tongues because they have not really understood from the word of God. We read in the Bible that all these gifts of The Holy Spirit operated right from our Lord Jesus Christ when He was in this earth, His disciples, then on Paul the Apostle and so forth.

If you are a local church pastor or a missionary or a servant of God, then we need to be very careful with our daily walk with God. As our Lord said to Abraham in Genesis 17:1, "*I am Almighty God, walk before Me and be blameless*". It is very

easy to say, but very tough to walk blameless before the holy Living God. But this is what He expects from each and every one of us daily even every minute. For this we need the anointing of The Holy Spirit. The heavenly anointing will protect us and the discerning Spirit of God will lead us in every way. Let us not become hindrances for people not to come closer to God. The enemy is looking for small faults to bring our Lords Name down and His work will be stopped. Our Lord, who called us, will be faithful till our last breathe to serve Him faithfully. He will not leave us nor forsake us. You are chosen people and generation. You have sacrificed your life obeying His call and because of this, your generation will be blessed in Jesus Name. When a servant of God with heavenly anointing walks blameless before God, the enemies' roots are shaken. Devil literally shivers before them because they will shake nations for God and bring souls to Christ. Nations will be reached through you, when you walk blameless before our Living God. Amen and Amen

Gift of speaking in Tongues (different kinds of Tongues)

What is a Tongue? It is an unknown or different language spoken by children of God when our Lord anoints them with His Holy Spirit. When our Lord anoints a person with The Holy Spirit, He confirms them by giving the gift of speaking in Tongues (as mentioned earlier). We can see this in many places in the Book of Acts. This is a very unique and important gift of The Holy Spirit because it will edify every individual and also the Body of Christ. Paul writes in 1 Corinthians 14:4, "*He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself*" and also in 1 Corinthians 14:5, "*I (Paul) wish you all spoke with tongues*". There are two kinds of Tongues as we read them in 1 Corinthians 13:1, "*The tongues of Men*" and "*Tongues of Angels*"

"*The tongues of Men*" are languages spoken by a person when anointed by The Holy Spirit, which is not known to him/her but known to others who speak those native languages. We see this in Acts 2. On the day of Pentecost, our Lord filled His disciples with the anointing of The Holy Spirit. They spoke different unknown languages. They did not know what they spoke but the people who were watching them were able to understand what they spoke. Our Lord will give His message

through the tongues of men to edify the individual and the Body of Christ, so that they can repent and come back to Him or to strengthen their Spirit

Secondly "*The tongues of Angels*" are unknown languages spoken by a person when anointed by The Holy Spirit, which is not known to him/her. It is also called as "*Divine or Heavenly language*". It can be the language of Angels as we read in 1 Corinthians 13:1. This gift is also to edify the individual and also the Body of Christ. In Acts 10:44-46, when Peter was sharing the message and when the gentiles believed in Christ, they received the anointing of the Holy Spirit. In Acts 19:6, when Paul laid his hands, they received the anointing of the Holy Spirit. In both the places we find, they spoke in unknown languages not known to anyone there. Some have the "*Gift of Interpretation of Tongues*" given by our Lord, to interpret the message given in this unknown language to edify the Body of Christ

God will speak supernaturally to His people by unknown tongues. We can read in 1 Corinthians 14:21-22, "*With men of other tongues and other lips I will speak to this people; And yet, for all that, they will not hear Me,*" says the Lord. Therefore tongues are for a sign, not to those who believe but to unbelievers. Also in Isaiah 28:11, "*For with stammering lips and another tongue He will speak to this people*". So God will speak through The Holy Spirit to His people with unknown tongues.

Not in every place in the Bible we read, the gift of tongues was interpreted. It will be good if someone has the gift of interpretation of tongues, who can interpret at that moment to edify the Body of Christ. But in Acts 10:44-46 and in Acts 19:6, we find people received the anointing of The Holy Spirit and spoke in tongues. In both places Peter and Paul have the gifts of

The Holy Spirit, still they did not interpret these tongues. Everyone who received the anointing of the Holy Spirit spoke aloud in tongues. So it is not mandatory to interpret. It is not the person who speaks by themselves, when they are moved by the anointing of The Holy Spirit, the Spirit of God speaks mysteries or they pray for others in different tongues given by The Holy Spirit. So do not be confused if someone in your local church speaks in tongues aloud. It is not wrong and it is not mandatory that someone has to interpret the tongues. But Paul later says 1 Corinthians 14, that *it will be good to have someone interpret the Tongues so that everyone is edified in the church.*

Sometimes people who do not have this experience will mock or make fun or be amazed too. We read this in Acts 2:12-13, *Amazed and perplexed, they asked one another, "What does this mean?" Some, however, made fun of them and said, "They have had too much wine".* This happened when the disciples spoke in their own language. So do not worry or be surprised, if someone makes fun of you. They will not understand this unless they go through similar experience or walk with The Holy Spirit. Also in Luke 1:41 we read, *"When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the baby leaped in her womb, and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit".* When Elizabeth was filled with The Holy Spirit, the baby (John the Baptist) moved or leaped. Sometimes, we might see when the anointing comes, people move from the place. They cannot withstand the presence of God which surrounds them in a mighty way. In Acts 4:31 we read, *"After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with The Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly".* The place was moved, when they prayed fervently with the anointing of The Holy Spirit. So, these are the few signs we find from the word of God when The Holy Spirit moved in a

mighty way. Do not be confused or worried, if something like this happens when the Spirit of God moves in a mighty way.

Most of the times the person who speaks in tongues can control themselves very well. Initially when they receive the anointing of the Holy Spirit, it will be a new experience and they do not know how to control the anointing. Later as the Holy Spirit teaches and guides them, they will know how to speak and when to speak. You can speak in tongues in your heart and no one will know that you are praying and interceding with our Lord. But sometimes, when our Lord anoints them immensely and wants to deliver His message to warn or edify the church, then they get overwhelmed with unknown tongues or languages. If they also have the gift of interpretation of tongues, then our Lord gives the message interpreted through someone else who has that gift. It is the same Spirit of God but works through different people in the body of Christ to edify the church and bring souls to Christ. Paul, the apostle says in 1 Corinthians 14, if you cannot interpret or do not have anyone to interpret the Tongues, then do not speak in tongues in open places or in Churches. Paul says in 1 Corinthians 14:19, "*In the Church, I would rather speak five words with my understanding that I may teach others also, than ten thousand words in a tongue*". Paul said this when there were no one to interpret at that situation. But if there is someone who can interpret the tongues then we should let them speak in tongues and also interpret. We are allowing the Spirit of God to take control of the local church service and He delivers the exact message what people need at that moment.

But when you are alone in your prayer room, you can pray in tongues openly with our God and even if you cannot interpret it is totally fine, since The Holy Spirit prays on your behalf to the Father for saints and this is the will of God as we

read in Romans 8:26-27. Also in 1 Corinthians 14:2 we read, *"For he speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God, for no one understands him; however, in the Spirit he speaks mysteries"*. So you pray and speak mysteries to God or declare the wonders of God in the Spirit, as we read in Acts 2: 11, *"we hear them declaring the wonders of God in our own tongues!"*

It is the responsibility of every Pastor in the local church to rightly identify the Apostles, Prophets, Teachers, and the Evangelists given by our Lord and allow The Holy Spirit to operate through them in every church service. This is very important. The Holy Spirit knows exactly the state of everyone who comes to the local church. When The Holy Spirit operates and speaks through His servants, the whole service will be different since there will be transformation of hearts and love of Christ will be manifested through operation of gifts and in addition, the body of Christ will also be edified. The local Pastor also needs to operate with the same anointing of the Holy Spirit, knowing which gifts should operate, that day, in the church and allow our Lord to speak through His people in an orderly manner. In Acts 20:28 we read, *"Keep watch over yourselves and all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers. Be shepherds of the church of God, which he bought with his own blood"*. Every Pastor has been appointed by The Holy Spirit. They have important work in His kingdom and it is not an easy work. Every day they need special grace and anointing from The Holy Spirit to work in His Kingdom. If they do not have time to fast and pray, wait at our Lord's feet, receive His special anointing and word from our Lord, then there will not be any fruit in the ministry. This is very important to know and the special anointing is very much needed. It is right time to examine ourselves before our Lord and commit our ways right, so that only His will be done in our life.

As mentioned earlier, the main purpose of operating the gifts of The Holy Spirit is to bring souls to His Kingdom and not for any other purpose. If you do not have the love for souls and to bring them to Christ yet have all these gifts then what is the use? This is what Paul writes in 1 Corinthians 13:1, *"If I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but do not have love, then I become like a sounding brass or a clanging cymbal"*. Nowadays, the word "Love" can be interpreted in many ways. It also refers to a relationship between a man and a woman. This is not what Paul referred. Paul refers to **Christ's AGAPE Love**, the unconditional Love of Christ to His Church, love of Christ to perishing souls and not worldly infatuation or worldly love. If you have Christ's love for perishing souls, then automatically you will do anything to bring them to Christ and this includes taking care of their worldly needs, by extending our worldly care or by extending our helping hands. Both go together. If we do not have love for perishing souls there is no use having all these nine gifts of The Holy Spirit. This is very important else we might misuse the gifts of The Holy Spirit and backslide one day and lose them. Many lost the grace, the anointing and the gifts of The Holy Spirit when their focus changed from God to themselves. In Bible we read in many places like Leviticus 19:18, Matthew 19:19 & 22:39, Mark 12:31-33, Luke 10:27, Romans 13:9, Galatians 5:14 and James 2:8, our Lord says, *"Love your neighbor as yourself"*. The real meaning is to love their soul, show Christ, help them to receive the gift of Salvation, in addition to physically help and love them worldly. When you want and like your soul to be in heaven with God eternally, then you should have the same passion for your neighbors too. Make sure he/she also comes with you to heaven eternally. What is the use of giving them all worldly help and losing their souls eternally? When we do not understand this, we try to help them financially here in this world and lose their soul

eternally. Both are needed. May our Lord open our eyes, so that the anointing which He gives us may help us to love our neighbors and their souls, so they come to heaven with us one day.

Jesus Christ our only Example or Role model

The Bible says in Ephesians 5:1, "*Be Imitators of God*" and in 1 Corinthians 11:1 Paul the Apostle says, "*Imitate me, just as I also Imitate Christ*". Our only example and role model in this world is our Lord Jesus Christ. If you keep anyone in His place as example, you will be failure for sure. Lord Jesus Christ lived a sinless and holy life in this world. No one is perfect like our Lord Jesus Christ. He is our only example and role model. He did not need to be water baptized, but He did to fulfill Lord's will and to be an example and role model for us. He is the powerful God, lived in this earth without any sin, still He fasted and prayed for forty days to be an example and role model for us. So when we fast and pray, The Holy Spirit will search us, cleanse us by His precious Blood and sanctify us to grow closer to Him. Paul the Apostle was able to follow Christ. Hence Paul said, imitate me. No one, other than Paul the Apostle, was able to comment the same way including Lord Jesus own disciples. The Bible clearly says that Lord Jesus Christ was filled with The Holy Spirit, He was with fullness of Holy Spirit, Led by the Spirit, Anointed by The Holy Spirit, Walked in the Spirit, Rejoiced in the Spirit, Sealed with the Holy Spirit, Praying in the Spirit and all nine gifts of The Holy Spirit operated in and

through Him including speaking of Tongues, unknown languages mentioned in three places. The Bible says in,

- *Matthew 3:16, Luke 3:22 - The Holy Spirit descended on him in bodily form like a dove.*
- *Acts 10:38 - God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power, and how he went around doing good and healing all who were under the power of the devil, because God was with him.*
- *Luke 4:1 - Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit*
- *Matthew 4:1, Luke 4:1 - Jesus led up the spirit*

Even though The Holy Spirit existed right from day one, Lord Jesus Christ was the first person, whom our Lord God baptized with The Holy Spirit as we read in Acts 10:38. He is "**THE ANOINTED ONE**". When He was led by the Spirit of God to fast and pray for forty days, God prepared Him during those days for His Ministry and anointed Him specially with the power of The Holy Spirit, so that all gifts of The Holy Spirit can operate through Him. The prophecy about Anointing Lord Jesus Christ in Isaiah 61:1 got fulfilled and the same was confirmed by Christ in Luke 4:18 as Lord Jesus said, "***The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me***"

So the anointing of The Holy Spirit happened from the days of Jesus Christ and not from the day of Pentecost. During the day of Pentecost, our Lord passed the same anointing which He had, from the Father to His disciples and other Apostles, as we read in Acts 2:33, "*Exalted to the right hand of God, he has received from the Father the promised Holy Spirit and has poured out what you now see and hear*". The Bible says, our Lord Jesus Christ along with God the Father created this world

with one Word and He does not need to fast and pray, wait for forty days, receive the anointing of The Holy Spirit to do His Ministry. But still, to set as an example for us, He showed us the path of preparation before we do His ministry. So it is very essential for every servant of God, to wait at our Lord's feet with much fasting and prayer, to receive the Power and Anointing of the Holy Spirit and then do His ministry effectively.

Without the gifts of The Holy Spirit, our Lord Jesus Christ would have not performed even one single miracle or healing. Today people think, divine healing, miracles, anointing of The Holy Spirit is for all people during days of Acts. It is not true and not right based on the word of God. The Bible says, Jesus is the same yesterday, today and forever. If He can anoint His disciples, He can give the same anointing and power of The Holy Spirit to everyone who seeks and waits at His feet, to perform divine healings and miracles. But everything operates for the expansion of His kingdom only and not for anyone's name or their Glory. So Lord Jesus Christ was anointed with power of The Holy Spirit during His Ministry days.

In three situations, we find our Lord Jesus Christ spoke in Tongues (unknown language) which was also interpreted by The Holy Spirit and it is given in the Bible. Lord Jesus Christ spoke in Tongues (unknown language), when He was specially anointed by The Holy Spirit to accomplish some major task, so that the purpose and will of God the Father in Heaven will be fulfilled

Firstly when we read Mark 5:21-43, Lord Jesus went to Jairus' house to raise his daughter who was dead. Jairus' was a Jew and he was one of the rulers of the synagogue. He spoke Hebrew just as our Lord Jesus Christ did. When Lord Jesus went to Jairus' house, He took only Jairus', Jairus' wife, His disciples

Peter, James and John inside Jairus' house. If you read verse 41 the Bible clearly says, "*Then HE took the child by the hand, and said to her, "TALITHA CUMI", which is translated, 'Little girl, I say to you, arise'.*" If you notice, "**Talitha cumi**" is an Aramaic language (unknown language) which is spoken by Persians. Jesus Christ did not speak in Hebrew here when everyone in the house knew Hebrew. Our Lord God Father anointed Lord Jesus Christ with the power of The Holy Spirit as we read in Acts 10:38, the anointing was so much; He spoke in Tongues and gifts of Faith, Healing and Miracle worked together at the same time along with the gift of Tongues. When gifts of The Holy Spirit operated through our Lord Jesus Christ, immediately Jairus' daughter came back to life. Amen

Now the important point is the interpretation of this Tongue (unknown language) which happened later by The Holy Spirit through His disciple Mark. If you again read in Mark 5:41 it says, "**it is translated, Little girl, I say to you, arise**". Mark was not there in that house along with Lord Jesus. Jesus spoke only "*Talitha cumi*", but The Holy Spirit interprets this Tongue later through his disciple Mark giving the meaning as "*Little girl, I say to you, arise*". None of them there inside the house know the meaning of "*Talitha cumi*" except Lord Jesus Christ (since He is the author of all languages) even Mark did not know the meaning since it is in Aramaic language, but the Gift of The Holy Spirit through Interpretation of Tongues operates through Mark. Here we find five (5) Gifts of The Holy Spirit were operated. This is one place where our Lord spoke in Tongues and the most important part is the miracle, Jairus' daughter coming back alive and through this miracle many believed Christ and came to Him.

If you again read Mark 5:43 you find Lord Jesus said, "*But*

He commanded them strictly that no one should know it". Jairus' daughter came back alive and it is the miracle what our Lord Jesus Christ did inside the house. How others would not know when the girl was dead earlier and then alive? What Jesus referred here was, He commanded them not to tell others what He spoke inside the house when miracle happened (about the unknown tongue). So that others outside, would not be confused with the new language He spoke inside the house (including Jairus' and his wife, His disciples). The Holy Spirit will never confuse anyone and if we allow Him to reveal the truth, He will do it at the right time, like how He did through disciple Mark. Amen.

Is it mandatory for Jesus to speak in an unknown language or Tongue to do this Miracle? Lord Jesus could have spoken in Hebrew or just touched her or just commanded her to come back to life with one word. When Lord Jesus spoke in tongues, nobody interpreted. We need to understand two important things here. Even though our Lord Jesus Christ could have done this miracle very easily, He subjected Himself totally to the move of The Holy Spirit. Secondly He allowed The Spirit of the living God to anoint Him and did what Father in Heaven expected Him to do and fulfill Father's will. He set himself as role model for us, so we should also submit and surrender to the move of The Holy Spirit to fulfill the will of God the Father in Heaven.

Secondly when we read in Mark 7: 31-37, we find Lord Jesus healed a deaf-mute man in Decapolis. When we read verse 33, Jesus took him aside from the multitude. Now the situation was Jesus and the deaf-mute man. His disciples and others were not close to him when this miracle happened. If we read Mark 7:34, "Then, looking up to Heaven, He sighed, and said to him, *"Ephphatha"*, that is, *"Be opened"*. If you notice "Ephphatha" is

an Aramaic language (an unknown language) which is spoken by Persians. Jesus Christ did not speak in Hebrew here. Our Lord God anointed Jesus Christ with the power of The Holy Spirit as we read in Acts 10:38, the anointing was so much; He spoke in Tongues and Gift of Faith, Healing and Miracle worked together at the same time along with the Gift of Tongues. When Gifts of The Holy Spirit operated through our Lord Jesus Christ, immediately deaf-mute person was healed totally.

Now the important point is the Interpretation of this Tongue (an unknown language) which happens later by The Holy Spirit through His disciple Mark. If you again read in Mark 7:34 it says, "**that is**, *"Be opened"*". Jesus spoke only *"Ephphatha"*, but The Holy Spirit interprets later through His disciple Mark giving the meaning *"Be opened"*. None of them knew the meaning of *"Ephphatha"* except Lord Jesus Christ (since He is the author of all languages) even Mark does not know the meaning since it is in Aramaic language, but the Gift of The Holy Spirit through Interpretation of Tongues operates through Mark. Here also we find five (5) Gifts of The Holy Spirit were operated. This is the other place where our Lord spoke in Tongues and the most important part is the Miracle, Deaf-mute person got healed and through which many came to Christ.

If you again read in Mark 7:36 you find our Lord said, *"But He commanded them that they should tell no one"*. Gentiles lived in this place and it was not a Sabbath day. What Lord Jesus referred here was He commanded them not to tell others about what He spoke when the miracle happened (about the unknown tongue). So others would not be confused with new language what Lord Jesus spoke. Later the meaning was revealed to disciple Mark by The Holy Spirit. Amen

Thirdly Jesus spoke an unknown language or Tongues, was the time when He gave His life and His Blood for every soul in this world at the cross. **He spoke at the cross.** If you read in Mark 15:34 and Matthew 27:46, "*And at the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?" which is translated, "My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?"*". Some say it is Syriac, others Aramaic language. But no one near the cross including Roman soldiers and others could not understand what Lord Jesus told (refer Mark 15:35). People around Him thought Jesus was calling Elijah (verse 35). **THIS IS ONE OF THE SEVEN PHRASE OR MESSAGE OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST SPOKE ON THE CROSS.** Jesus Christ did not speak in Hebrew there. Our Lord God anointed Lord Jesus Christ with the power of The Holy Spirit and strength as we read in Acts 10:38, The anointing was so much He spoke in Tongues giving His whole life for the mission to be accomplished for every soul in this world to fulfill Fathers will. The Holy Spirit anointed Lord Jesus and strengthened Him, when He went through the agony and death at the Cross.

The Interpretation of this Tongue (an unknown language) happened later by The Holy Spirit through his disciple Mark. If you again read in Mark 15:34 it says, ""**which is translated, My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me**". Jesus spoke only "*Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?*", but The Holy Spirit interpreted later through His disciple Mark giving the meaning "*My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me*". None of them knew the meaning except Lord Jesus Christ (since He is the author of all languages) and His disciple Mark, when the Gift of The Holy Spirit through Interpretation of Tongues operated through him. This is the other place where our Lord spoke in Tongues and fulfilled Fathers will.

One thing for sure, Our Lord anointed His disciple Mark specially with the Gift of interpretation of Tongues and we see only Mark could translate most of our Lords unknown Tongues, when that gift operated through him.

Aramaic language is spoken natively in Iran, Iraq, Israel, Syria, Turkey, Jordan and Palestine mostly by native Persians

So, all Gifts of The Holy Spirit operated through our Lord Jesus Christ including speaking of Tongues. God the Father anointed Lord Jesus to complete His mission in this world. If our Lord Jesus Christ needed the Anointing, Power and Gifts of The Holy Spirit to fulfill Father's will, then don't we all need the same Anointing of The Holy Spirit to do His work here in this world?

Paul the Apostle also had same gifts like our Lord Jesus Christ and other chosen disciples. One important and good thing about Paul the Apostle was, he replaced the place of the twelfth (12th) disciple and performed our Lord's Ministry faithfully. When our Lord Jesus Christ chose His disciples, He prayed the whole night before He chose them. Jesus Christ never chose any of His disciples by voting or any lot system. We can read this in Luke 6:12, "*Jesus Christ went to the mountain, prayed all night to God and next day He chose twelve disciples and named them as Apostles*". All these twelve were chosen by our Lord Jesus Christ. **Certain things are given in the Bible, so we do not follow them** (Just like the example of Samson). The Holy Spirit has placed the story of Samson in the Bible just to remind us not to be like Samson. God gives them like instructions, alerts and teaches us not to follow the same process. One such thing is also choosing of the twelfth disciple when Judas betrayed Jesus. When we read in Acts 1:23-26, His other disciples chose Barsabas, Matthias and they cast lot between them and elected

Matthias as their twelfth disciple. If it was God's will and plan, then Matthias would have done Lord's ministry replacing Judas' position. Also we find, His disciples chose Matthias before God anointed them with the Holy Spirit before the day of Pentecost. If they had waited for a few more days, maybe The Holy Spirit would have revealed to them the right person as the twelfth disciple. But they did not wait. We do not read anything about Matthias after this incident in the Bible. But our Lord replaced Matthias' position with Saul, who was later named as Paul. Paul had one-on-one interaction directly with Christ like any other disciples as we read in Acts 9. Christ met Saul who later became Paul, but He did not meet Matthias. Our Lord replaced Paul in the place of Matthias and fulfilled His work and ministry through him. Paul the Apostle walked with the same anointing of the Holy Spirit like any other chosen disciple of Christ. Our Lord does not want people to be chosen on lot or vote system for His ministry. Everywhere we find Lord Jesus prayed, He chose them and had direct interaction with His disciples and called them for the work to be fulfilled including Paul. So we understand in God's Kingdom, nothing will work with our flesh or our thoughts or our decisions. If our Lord wants to bring the right person in His ministry, He will remove and replace them with His chosen vessel and will perform what needs to be done according to His will. Amen.

So if you are a servant of God or a church Pastor and need someone for Lord's ministry, then first fast and pray, then do what our Lord wants to do by choosing right person, whom our Lord chooses for His ministry. Let us not chose people by voting or lot system for His work. This is not our ministry. This is our Lords ministry through us. He will guide and show us when we fast and pray. Let His ministry be fulfilled through the one whom He chooses like Paul else we will have people like Matthias in

our team doing nothing for God and wasting everyone's time including our Lord's time. **Whom are we pleasing? Any man? (or) our Lord Jesus Christ?** This is a good lesson for every servant of God. God does not want to use whom man chooses. He wants to use whom He chooses for His ministry. Our Lord used Paul the same way He used Peter and other disciples.

When we read about Paul in the Bible, we find in,

- *Acts 13:9 - Then Saul, who was also called Paul, filled with the Holy Spirit*
- *1 Corinthians 14:18 - I (Paul) thank my God I speak with tongues more than you all*
- *1 Corinthians 14:2 - For he speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God, for no one understands him; however, in the Spirit he speaks mysteries*
- *1 Corinthians 14:4 - He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself*
- *1 Corinthians 14:14 - For if I pray in a tongue, my spirit prays, but my understanding is unfruitful*
- *1 Corinthians 14:5 - I (Paul) wish you all spoke with tongues*
- *1 Corinthians 14:22 - Therefore tongues are for a sign, not to those who believe but to unbelievers*
- *1 Corinthians 14:39 - Do not forbid to speak with tongues*
- *1 Corinthians 3: 16, 17 - Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in*

you? If anyone defiles the temple of God, God will destroy him

Paul the apostle was filled with The Holy Spirit. Paul the apostle spoke in Tongues more than anyone of us. Hence God edified his spirit and used him to write books for all churches. None of the books Paul wrote was from his flesh or from his intellect; he was totally moved by the presence of God and the anointing of The Holy Spirit and wrote what was told by The Holy Spirit. Gifts of The Holy Spirit operated through him and people received healings. Miracles were performed through Paul. When Paul touched, people received the anointing of The Holy Spirit and healing. Paul's dress carried the anointing of The Holy Spirit. Dead were raised like how Jesus did. This is how our Lord will use a person when He chooses His servant. There will be a huge difference in the Ministry. If Paul did not receive the anointing of The Holy Spirit there would not be any difference between Paul and Mathias. God would have used some other person in Paul's place to fulfill His ministry.

How The Holy Spirit will operate?

Finally let us also understand more about how The Holy Spirit will operate in a person at every stage of spiritual life or walk,

- *Filled / Fullness with The Holy Spirit*
- *Praying in the Spirit*
- *Walking in the Spirit / Led by The Holy Spirit*
- *Sealed with The Holy Spirit*

Since the Spirit of God led me to write about the Anointing, Power and Baptism of The Holy Spirit, I am not going in detail on Fruit of the Spirit or gifts of the Holy Spirit or about praying in the Spirit or about walking in the Spirit or about led by The Holy Spirit or about sealed with The Holy Spirit.

You have the author The Holy Spirit within you and when you spend more time at our Lords feet, He will teach you. He is the best Teacher. He will open your eyes to see the truth from the word of God. *May our Lord give you the gifts of The Holy Spirit like "The word of Knowledge" and "The word of Wisdom" to know more about Him.*

Filled with The Holy Spirit

(Anointing or Baptism or Filling or Fullness of The Holy Spirit)

The first stage when The Holy Spirit works in our life is to fill and anoint us with His Power and Fire. When God fills and anoints a person, with His Holy Spirit on overflowing measure, it is called as "***Filled with the Holy Spirit***". The more we empty ourselves and allow our Lord to fill us with His Holy Spirit, the more He will do than we ask. Unless He fills us we cannot do anything with our own strength. When our Lord fills us you will see the Gifts of the Holy Spirit operating in your life to edify the Body of Christ along with the Fruits of The Holy Spirit

As we read in,

- *Ephesians 5: 18, Paul writes "Be filled with the Spirit". We also see in other places about filling by the Holy Spirit,*
- *Acts 13:9 - Then Saul, who was also called Paul, filled with the Holy Spirit*
- *Acts 13:52 - And the disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit*
- *Luke 1:15 for he will be great in the sight of the Lord. He is never to take wine or other fermented drink, and he will be filled with the Holy Spirit even before he is born (about John the Baptist)*
- *Luke 1:41 - When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the baby leaped in her womb, and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit*
- *Luke 1:67 - His father Zechariah was filled with the*

Holy Spirit and prophesied

- *Acts 2:4 - And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance*
- *Acts 4:8, 13 - Peter filled with the Holy Spirit & he spoke boldly*
- *Ephesians 5: 18 - Be filled with the Spirit*
- *Acts 10:38 - God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power*
- *Matthew 3:11 - He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire*
- *Acts 6:5 - They chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit;*
- *Acts 7:55 - But Stephen, full of the Holy Spirit*
- *Acts 11:24 - He was a good man, full of the Holy Spirit and faith, and a great number of people were brought to the Lord*
- *Luke 4:1 - Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit*
- *Luke 10:21 - Jesus Rejoiced in the Spirit - (when God revealed truth to HIS disciples)*
- *2 Corinthians 13:14 - the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all*

Praying in The Spirit

Once our Lord anoints you with The Holy Spirit, He will lead you to pray in the Spirit. This is the second stage which The

Holy Spirit leads us. When you are filled with The Holy Spirit, the Spirit of God prays on behalf of you to the Heavenly Father and does intercession for His saints and ministries. We read about Anna, a prophetess, who served God all her life with Fasting and prayers. Praying in the Holy Spirit edifies our spiritual inner man. During this stage, our Lord reveals most of His plan, His thoughts to His servants. Many gifting of The Holy Spirit operates in this stage along with the Fruits of The Holy Spirit.

There are few verses which talks about Praying in the Spirit,

- *Romans 8:26-27 - Holy Spirit prays on your behalf to the Father for the saints and this is the will of God*
- *Jude 1:20 - dear friends, by building yourselves up in your most holy faith and praying in the Holy Spirit*
- *Luke 2: 37 - Anna, a prophetess.....but served God with fasting and prayers night and day*
- *1 Corinth 14:2 - For he speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God.....in the Spirit he speaks mysteries*
- *Acts 2: 11 - declare the wonders of God*

Walking in The Spirit or Led by The Holy Spirit

The third stage which our Lord leads us is 'Walking in the Spirit'. Leading every step of our life based on His will. Every believer should long to walk and led by The Holy Spirit. It is a wonderful experience. In this stage, we totally surrender to God and The Holy Spirit tells us what to do in every stage. When we walk in the Spirit, we can see the Gifts and Fruit of The Holy Spirit operating in a higher way. You can see most of the

Apostles and Prophets of God walked with God and spoke to God like a friend, when they walked or led by The Holy Spirit (like Abraham, King David, Prophet Isaiah, disciples of our Lord Jesus, Paul the Apostle and so on..) It is a total surrender of life to Christ and His Holy Spirit. Our Lord Jesus Christ was led by the Spirit before He was tempted by Satan and we read them in Matthew 4:1 and also in Luke 4:1.

There are few verses which talks about Walking in the Spirit,

- *Matthew 4:1 - Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil*
- *Luke 4:1 - Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, left the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness*
- *Romans 8:14 - For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God*
- *Gal 5:16, 18, 25 - Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.....But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law....If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit*

Sealed with The Holy Spirit

The final stage will be sealed with The Holy Spirit. When we walk with our Lord and with His Holy Spirit, our Lord seals us for His Glory. We are being sealed or waxed and be strong with The Holy Spirit, this means we are totally under His control. When we walk closer to God and with His Holy Spirit, He seals us. Everything is under His control. In the Bible, we read about our Lord Jesus Christ, John the Baptist been sealed and waxed with The Holy Spirit. When we are sealed with The

Holy Spirit, even to touch us, devil needs to get permission from our Lord like he looked for the life of Job or Peter.

There are few verses which talks about Sealed with the Spirit,

- *Ephesians 1:13 - In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise*
- *Ephesians 4:30 - And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption*
- *Luke 1:80 - John the Baptist became strong in the Spirit*
- *Luke 2:40 - Jesus grew and became strong in the Spirit*
- *John 6:27 - Do not labor for the food which perishes, but for the food which endures to everlasting life, which the Son of Man will give you, because God the Father has set His seal on Him*
- *2 Corinth 1:21-22 - Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and has anointed us is God, who also has sealed us and given us the Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee*
- *Job 2: 4 -- devil is asking permission to touch Job*
- *Job 2:5-6 -- Lord gives Satan permission to touch his bone and his flesh but not to touch his life*
- *Luke 22:31-32 - Jesus prayed for Peter to build his faith because Satan was asking for Peter's life*

When you are sealed with The Holy Spirit, nothing in your

life happens without the permission of our Lord and The Holy Spirit. As Bible says in Romans 8:28, "*And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose*". This will happen when our life is sealed and waxed with The Holy Spirit.

- *Ephesians 6:17 - Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.*

May our Lord open your eyes, may you understand His word and know, experience The Holy Spirit in a deeper way. Do not worry about your past life, the troubles you had, the backslidden life. Jesus Christ still loves you. He needs you. Repent and come back to Him. Let Him cleanse you with His precious Blood and revive the gift of Salvation. He has a purpose in your life and He wants to use you powerfully for His Glory. Ask our Lord to anoint you and fill you with His Holy Spirit.

May our Lord anoint you with His Power, Fire and His gifts of The Holy Spirit, to edify the body of Christ for the expansion of His kingdom only. May the gifts of The Holy Spirit operate through

you and in the Body of Christ, to edify His church. May you have a wonderful walk of life with The Holy Spirit every day. Have a heart to know Him more and wait at His feet with fasting and much prayer. May the Lord use you to weed out the roots of devil and raise His banner in this earth. May souls be added in the body of Christ every day through you and your prayers.

Now it is your time to decide, prepare, commit and surrender to our Lord's will, so that He can use you powerfully for His work and for His Glory.

At this moment, I thank our Lord Jesus Christ for specially giving me His grace to complete this book for HIS Glory. At one moment I was not even sure whether I would be able to complete this book. His Grace was sufficient for me.

May our Lord use each and every one of us who reads this book. As you plan to spend time at our Lord's feet with fasting and prayer, may our Lord Jesus Christ mould you, anoint you with His power and use you powerfully in the days to come, to expand His Kingdom during these last days.

Do not keep this book idle. Pass this book to everyone in your family, to every believer, to your prayer group members, to members in your local church so that everyone will know and understand The Spirit of God in a very personal way. We are going to see a huge revival, going to happen around us and the Lord is preparing His church for that only. May His will be done on earth as it is in Heaven.

May all Praise, Glory and Honor be to God the Father, our Lord Jesus Christ and HIS Holy Spirit only for ever and ever. Amen.

- HE will dwell with you & will be in you - John 14:17, 1 Corinthians 3:16, 2 Timothy 1:14
- HE will help us - 2 Timothy 1:14
- HE will do intercession for HIS people (saints)- Romans 8:26-27
- HE will help in our weakness - Romans 8:26
- HE will separate people for HIS Ministry or fulfill HIS Calling - Acts 13:2
- HE will warn us for the hardship we will face in Ministry - Acts 20:23
- HE will strengthen us and give us HIS Power - Acts 1:8
- HE will sanctify us - 1 Peter 1:2, 1 Thessalonians 5:23, 2 Thessalonians 2:13
- HE will teach you what to speak or say - Luke 12:12
- HE will make us to be witness for Christ - Acts 1:8
- HE will deliver people from evil Spirit and bondages - Matthew 12:28
- HE will give us Joy - Acts 13:52, Luke 10:21, 1 Thessalonians 1:6
- HE will encourage us - Acts 9:31
- HE will pour out Gods Love - Romans 5:5
- HE will fellowship with us - 2 Corinthians 13:14
- HE gives us understanding - Colossians 1:9

In three situations, we find our Lord Jesus Christ spoke in Tongues (an unknown language) and was also interpreted by The Holy Spirit as given in the Bible. Lord Jesus Christ spoke in Tongues when He was specially anointed by The Holy Spirit (as given in Acts 10:38) to accomplish major tasks, so that the purpose and will of God the Father in Heaven will be fulfilled.
